DEFINITION:

AWARDS DETAILS:

Awards will be given to students of Grade 3 to Grade 9 and Grade 11 at the end of the academic year. Below are the Awards and their respective criteria:

PRINCIPAL'S SPECIAL AWARD	Principal's special award will be conferred to the student/s from each cohort Cohorts refer to the following: • Grade 3 to 5 • Grade 6 to 8 • Grade 9 and Grade 11 ➤ Should attain at least 90% marks in core subjects and at least 80% in Ministry subjects. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. ➤ Should be present for all the internal assessments. ➤ Should be the overall top scorer across the cohort. ➤ Should have made any outstanding contribution which has brought laurels to the school in any field ➤ Principal's decision will be the final.



PRINCE AND PRINCESS		One boy and one girl across the grade will be crowned as 'DUNES PRINCE' and 'DUNES PRINCESS'. ➤ Should attain at least 90% marks in core subjects and at least 80% in Ministry subjects. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. ➤ Should be present for all the internal assessments. ➤ Should be the overall top scorer across the grade. ➤ Should have impactful contribution in the intra/ inter school and community based co-curricular activities. A panel interview will be conducted for all the eligible students.
SCHOLAR OF THE YEAR		One student across the grade ➤ Should attain at least 90% marks in core subjects and at least 80% in Ministry subjects. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. ➤ Should be present for all the internal assessments. Should be the overall top scorer across the grade.
LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY	ARABIC	One student across the grade ➤ Should be the overall top scorer in that particular language. ➤ Minimum score should be 90% in that language. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. ➤ Should be present for all the internal assessments of that particular subject. A minimum of 6 students must have opted the language(Applicable for Hindi/French/CBSE Arabic from grade 5 upwards)

EINSTEIN AWARD (SCIENCE PROFICIENCY AWARD)		One student across the grade ➤ Should be the overall top scorer in Science ➤ Minimum score should be 90%. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. Should be present for all the internal assessments of that subject.



SUBJECT PROFICIENCY AWARD (For grade 11) Physics, Chemistry ,Biology, Economics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship, Computer Science and Physical education will be considered separately	One student across the grade ➤ Should be the overall top scorer in a particular subject ➤ Minimum score should be 90%. ➤ Minimum 95% attendance for the year. ➤ Should be present for all the internal assessments of that particular subject. A minimum of 6 students must have opted the subject(For grade 11)
TECH WIZARD	One student across the grade ➤ Should have shown exceptional interest in Robotics activities and Computer prodigy. Should have impactful contribution in the intra/ inter school and community based co-curricular activities.
PROMISING ARTIST (DRAWING, PAINTING and CRAFT)	One student across the grade ➤ Should have shown exceptional interest in visual art (Drawing, Painting and Craft) Should have impactful contribution in the intra/ inter school and community based co-curricular activities.
SANGEET VISHARAD (MUSIC)	One student across the grade ➤ Should have shown exceptional interest in Performing art (Music). ➤ Should have impactful contribution in the intra/ inter school and community based co-curricular activities.
EXQUISITE FEET (DANCE)	One student across the grade ➤ Should have shown exceptional interest in Performing Art (Dance). ➤ Should have impactful contribution in the intra/ inter school and community based co-curricular activities.
CHAMPION OF THE YEAR (SPORTS)	One student across the grade ➤ Should have shown exceptional performance in sports activities. ➤ Should have impactful contribution in the intra/inter school and community based co-curricular activities.
ENVIRONMENTALIST	One student across the grade. ➤ Should have shown sustained commitment and dedication towards environment and community affairs. This can be through volunteering, social enterprises, education or any other initiatives. ➤ Recommendation or appreciation from authorized environmental agencies, school eco-club or third party endorsement will be considered as an additional element.
