The Robotic lab is a bright and generous space where children can spread out to do their inventing. There are computer stations where children can test and program their robots. Students learn to build robots using the latest Robotics Systems, as well as principles of motion and gearing, and use of light, touch, ultrasonic sensors. Students compete in a variety of robotic challenges that include drones, mazes, obstacle ride, races etc.

 - You will be assigned a numbered Mindstorms kit which you must sign for.
 - If you lose or damage any kit pieces, you must pay for the replacement.
 - All robot kits and parts must stay in the lab or designated area at all times.
 - If you do not turn in a complete kit at the end of the term, you will receive an incomplete until the full kit is complete.

 - Computers are to be used for class work / projects.
